- School Recovery Plan for Covid is to focus on core subjects (reading and Math)
- Audrey McDonald School Networking program: working with other schools to build community support and programming.
 - o Caroline: working with Dawson to create a healing garden
- Carlton University is helping to design outdoor classroom space. They will be meeting with the community soon for ideas and planning designs NND will be looking to garner community support from VOM and JV Clark to gain financial sponsorship.
- FNNND Pro-D day orientation will be in November, next available time that works for school staff and FNNND.

New Business:

- Secretary Treasurer: Sarah will do these duties, but would like help from other council members for minute taking. Agreed

- Pancake breakfast: Yes, we will host a welcome back breakfast September 27. Ian and Teresa will organize food and cooking.
- **Hot Lunch Program:** Erin Profit is the new cook. Still organizing a menu and food order. Will be 5 days a week.
- Lauren Baranik worked with new staff (Bret, Patrick, & Remy) to provide FNNND resources and ideas for working FNNND culture into classroom content. Spent a few hours with each teacher. This will be an ongoing working relationship with FNNND throughout year.

School Growth Plan:

- o Funding is available through the Department for creating the school growth plan.
- Purpose of plan is to identify: what's working, not working and why, where do we go next.
- o Current plan focuses on literacy feeds into covid recovery plan.

Attendance:

- o Idea to talk to students and parents individually to encourage participation in school.
- A need to support parents in getting kids to school
- o 2 school bus runs?
- Parent engagement is key
- We do give out gift cards & bikes as a reward system for attendance. Not working to bring kids back to school.
- Ask other schools what they do to support attendance
- o Create a gathering space for students and community
- o More space for fun, e.g. tick tock videos created by teachers and students
 - Provide a variety of activities for students to choose to engage in. More collaboration with FNNND. Teresa and Lauren are willing to provide substitute activities and teaching if needed (e.g. teacher is away).
 - Moose hunting season: organize a day to process a moose with the students.

- Every-Child-Everyday funding: The school was awarded money last year, not spent yet.
 What is the current plan? When will this happen? Meant to create a social space for students. Mahshid will look into it.
- Shop class: would like council to support an application from the Youth Incentive Grant for new tools and supplies. Council may not be able to do this as we already applied for funding through this program for the Pottery club. Don't know if we can apply twice in the same year. lan to look into it.
- Kitchen: all new appliances and supplies. Still need ventilation updated. Someone was supposed to come last year to fix it, but didn't. **Trevor will look into this**.
