Guest Teachers: Mahshid Hassani and Chloe Edbrooke

Spoke about the differences between PM benchmark and Read Well programs. Are currently teaching the PM Benchmark program with the phonics section of Read Well. If parents would like their student to continue in the Read Well program teachers can send packages home. But in class will be PM Benchmark. Parents are welcome to visit the class and see how the program works. Mahshid has seen literacy improvements in all gr. 1-2 students.

Pat Spence has been acting as the LAT teacher. Has tested all students (K-12) in literacy. Students not at grade level will receive one on one help to get them up to grade level.

Rosemary has been working with teachers to train in teaching literacy with the PM Benchmark program. Provides consistency for students.
